

Map Your Neighborhood 9-steps: What to do in Emergency

The MYN meeting in your neighborhood will prepare you and your neighbors to take these simple steps together

MYN: Meeting prep

- Contact CERT to get MYN supplies and DVD that can lead you through this simple, powerful preparedness program. 541-552-2226
- You learn these steps together, with your neighbors
- Set a date and invite your neighbors



MYN: The 9 Steps

- Step 1- Take care of your loved ones
- Step 2- Protect your head, hands and feet



- Step 3- Natural Gas shut-off (earthquake)
- Step 4- Water shut-off (earthquake)
- Step 5- post OK / HELP sign
- Step 6- Fire extinguisher on sidewalk

Step 7- Gathering Site

 Step 7- Check in at Neighborhood Gathering site This site is determined on at your neighborhood meeting. Bring your emergency supplies.



- Covered, easy to see (porch, garage)
- Write the location it your MYN guide

Step 8- Organized Response

- On our way, look for signs (HELP-OK)
- We have 4 tasks so we need 4 crews
- A- Monitors radio- emergency broadcasts
- B- Goes to check on known special needs
- C- Gas and water shut-off (earthquake)
- D- Door to door check for HELP or no signs



Step 9- Meet Back

- Report back. Your crew is done with its work.
 Go back to the gathering site, share what you have done, assess what else needs to be done.
- Those are the 9 Steps
