#### **SUMMARY**

Appointment of three vacant positions on the Citizens' Budget Committee with two terms ending June 30, 2023 and one term ending June 30, 2024.

#### BACKGROUND AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Citizens' Budget Committee members Paula Hyatt and Shaun Moran terms ended on December 31, 2021 when they became elected to the City Council. Committee member Pamela Lucas resigned effective immediately in January 2021. Notice was made to the public of these vacancies. Eleven citizens applied.

At the March 2<sup>nd</sup> Business Meeting, Councilmembers voted for their top three choices to fill the three vacancies in three succeeding ballots, progressively narrowing the field of applicants but ran out of time to complete the voting.

Four votes out of seven is the minimum ultimately needed for appointment of any applicant. In the final three-votes-per-Councilmember ballot on March 2, Amery and Runkel each received 5 votes, and Alphonso and Slattery each received 4 votes. There are several alternatives for now reaching a conclusion. The simplest alternative – and the one that avoids possibilities of multiple subsequent ballots or tie votes – would be to appoint the two applicants who already received 5 votes and fill the remaining vacancy by means of a final vote as follows: Each Councilmember casts one vote for either of the two applicants who already received 4 votes, and the one receiving at least 4 votes would be appointed, along with the two already decided upon.

Once the three appointees have been chosen, a decision must be made as to which one of them will fill the position with a term ending 6/30/24 and which two will fill the positions with terms ending 6/30/23. Staff suggests that this decision be made by public drawing of lots – a method adopted by the City Charter for making similar decisions in other circumstances.
