# Be Prepared for Wildfire Emergencies

May 6 is Wildfire Community Preparedness Day. It's a good time to check your preparations. See below for steps to take and helpful resources:



- Prepare a disaster supplies kit and "go" bag. Pick up a list at Ashland Senior Center or learn more at <u>ready.gov/kit</u> and <u>jacksoncountyor.org/</u> emergency/Preparedness/Emergency-Kit.
- Make a plan. Learn more at <u>ready.gov/plan</u>. This might include signing up with the Disaster Registry, if you would need help to evacuate or shelter-in-place, at <u>rvcog.org/home/sds-2/emergency-preparedness/disaster-registry</u> or 541-664-6674.
- ✓ Stay informed. Sign up for emergency alerts: City of Ashland Nixle (text 97520 to 888777) and County Citizen Alert (<u>rvem.org</u>). Get updated information by calling the Wildfire Hotline (541-552-2490), listening to 1700 AM radio, and checking <u>ashland.or.us/smokewise</u>.

# Changes to Insurance Coverage for COVID-19

On May 11, the federal COVID-19 public health emergency will end. Vaccines remain free while federally-purchased supplies last; after that there will likely be a charge. See below for details on how this will affect access to COVID-19 tests and treatment, depending on insurance. It is best to check directly with your insurance provider.

**Original Medicare**: No more free at-home test kits. Possible cost-sharing for PCR/rapid tests and pharmaceutical treatments.

**Medicare Advantage** and **Private Insurance**: Possible cost-sharing for at home test kits, PCR/rapid tests, and pharmaceutical treatments.

**Medicaid**: At-home, PCR/rapid tests and pharmaceutical treatments remain free through September 2024 with possible cost-sharing after that date.
